

## Air Quality Management Area Revocation Order

**Rochford District Council** ("The Council"), in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(2)(b) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the **Air Quality Management Area (Rochford District Council) (No. 1) Revocation Order 2013** and shall come in to effect on **1 April 2013**.
2. The effect of the Order is to revoke as an Air Quality Management Area ('AQMA'), the area shown outlined in red on the plan in Schedule 1 which incorporates all premises on Rawreth Industrial Estate and some residential premises in the following streets:
  - a) Rowan Close;
  - b) Stirling Close;
  - c) Victoria Avenue.
3. The AQMA was designated in relation to a likely breach of the particles (PM<sub>10</sub>) 24-hour mean Objective as specified in the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000, as amended.
4. This Order revokes the **Air Quality Management Area (Rochford District Council) (No. 1) Order 2010** which was made on 7 May 2010.
