

Air Quality Management Area Revocation Order

Rochford District Council ("The Council"), in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(2)(b) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Air Quality Management Area (Rochford District Council) (No. 1) Revocation Order 2013 and shall come in to effect on 1 April 2013.
- 2. The effect of the Order is to revoke as an Air Quality Management Area ('AQMA'), the area shown outlined in red on the plan in Schedule 1 which incorporates all premises on Rawreth Industrial Estate and some residential premises in the following streets:
 - a) Rowan Close:
 - b) Stirling Close;
 - c) Victoria Avenue.
- The AQMA was designated in relation to a likely breach of the particles (PM₁₀) 24-hour mean Objective as specified in the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000, as amended.
- 4. This Order revokes the Air Quality Management Area (Rochford District Council) (No. 1) Order 2010 which was made on 7 May 2010.
