Lead local flood authority Essex CC.

The role of local authorities should be enhanced so that they take on responsibility for leading the co-ordination of flood risk management in their areas". The Act provides for this through the new role of the lead local flood authority.

A Review (2009) recommended that the lead local flood authority should bring together all relevant bodies to help manage local flood risk. District councils are included because they are identified as risk management authorities

Funding

Defra is committed to funding all net new burdens on local authorities resulting from the new Act, and will monitor the situation as implementation proceeds.

The EU Floods Directive

Alongside the 2010 Act, the Flood Risk Regulations 2009 have been made to implement the Floods Directive in England and Wales. These regulations outline the roles and responsibilities of the various authorities consistent with the Flood and Water Management Act and provide for the delivery of the outputs required by the Directive:

These are:-

- Preliminary Flood Risk Assessments (PFRAs), which will allow the Identification of areas of potential significant risk.
- Maps showing impact and extent of possible future significant flood events.
- Flood risk management plans, identifying how significant flood risks are to be mitigated.
