## Miscellaneous

As you are aware, I have made representations and would like a considered response to them, preferably from RDC, or from the inspector. Can you clarify if a fully considered response will be provided to each representations made, before the completion of the core strategy process and who will be providing it (presumably either RDC and/or the Inspector). What evidence will be provided to ensure that each representation has been properly considered?

I attach below the relevant paragraph from the Inspectors Procedure Notes, which I hope answers your query.

Noting that we are not dealing with 'inquiries into objections', reports will not summaries the cases of individual parties, should avoid as far as possible direct references to specific representations and should not describe discussions at the hearing sessions. The report will explain why the Inspector, based on a consideration of all the evidence and his/her professional expertise and judgment, has reached a particular view on legal compliance and soundness.
