"The planning points outlined in section 2.4 to 2.8 of the government policy document are basically saying that more land that is suitable should be freed up for housing and business use. Rochford council should consider a review of all existing areas that are not used or are unsuitable for agricultural use along corridors such as the A127 whether they are in designated green belt corridors or not, as development in some of these places would make very little environmental impact and probably enhance job creation and increase housing stock without encroaching on true agricultural and forestry areas."
