- when reviewing planning applications, encourage close partnership working with the Council to deliver local services which give the best deal for the community.










Parish Map







Rochford Overview

- Total Population of the Parish is 8,471
 - ✓ Up from 7,610 in 2001
 - ✓ Average age of 40.49 slightly lower than District average of 42.33

- Number of Dwellings in the Parish is 3,748
 - ✓ Population density of 6.9 people per hectare, slightly higher than District average of 4.9





Education Overview

Currently within the Parish there is:

- **□** 1 Secondary School:
 - ✓ King Edmund School



- Currently at 95% capacity
- ✓ Anticipated 97% in 2020

- **□** 2 Primary Schools:
 - ✓ Waterman Primary School
 - Rochford Primary School
 - ✓ Proposed Hall Road School



- ✓ Currently at 97% capacity
- ✓ Anticipated 100% in 2020
- √ 92% capacity of wider area in 2020



Business Overview

- Currently 520 rating-assessed businesses in the Parish
 - ✓ These range from shops to offices to ATMs.
 - ✓ Generally does not include self-employed or farms

- □ Rochford Parish has a good mix of business uses including offices, retail, fresh foods etc.
 - ✓ But there may be attractive business uses absent
 - ✓ What can be done to attract these kind of businesses?





Infrastructure Overview

- Rochford Parish has strong public transport links to London, Rayleigh and Southend
 - ✓ Very regular train and bus services
 - ✓ Do these services meet the needs of parishioners?
- London Southend airport
 - ✓ Does the airport meet the needs of parishioners?
- Options for sustainable transport cycling, walking routes etc.
- ☐ Utilities and Superfast broadband widely available





Conservation and Culture

- Rochford Parish has a designated Conservation Area which extends from Rochford Hundred Golf Club to the Town Centre
- Conservation areas are 'Areas of Special Architectural or Historic Interest,' the character and appearance of which we want to preserve
- Designation of a conservation area extends planning controls over certain types of development
- Rochford has particular historical value which deserves preservation






Listed Buildings

- Rochford Parish has around 85 Nationally Listed Buildings and around 32 Locally Listed buildings
- Buildings of architectural or historic interest make an important contribution to the character of the area
- □ The Council has a duty to preserve their qualities for both present and future generations
- ☐ The Council has a degree of control over development which affects Listed Buildings
