3. Presentation by Dave Chapman and Ed Clarke, Essex County Council, on the **Flood Alleviation Scheme in Rayleigh West and Sweyne Park and school area.**

Essex County Council Highways (ECCH)

4. Laburnum Way, Rayleigh - ECC working on the redesign of the culvert.
5. High Road, Hockley – capacity of existing surface water systems.
6. Eastwood Rise, Rayleigh – clearance of gullies and channel serving the surfaced carriageway.
7. High Street, Rayleigh – flooding on pedestrian area adjacent water trough.
8. 20 Marylands Avenue, Hockley – Flooding to property from public highway – ECCH have been contacted.

Anglian Water Authority (AWA)

9. Flood park Magnolia Public Open Space – AW investigating the situation of clearance works to flood park to restore original capacity.

Rochford District Council (RDC)

10. Nobles Green ditch, Rayleigh – RDC discussed with ECC Flood Team about grant for the works, not eligible as it is a classified main river and AW are due to do some works.
