1. **Agree Minutes of meeting held on 24 January 2017**
2. **Completed Schemes**
 - 92 Trinity Road – ECCH has installed an enlarged gully.
 - Sweyne Park/Sweyne School – Flood alleviation scheme works being carried out by ECC Flood Team.
 - 20 Marylands Avenue, Hockley – Flooding to property from public highway – a gully installed to connect with the existing gully.
 - Warwick Close/Warwick Road – drain off Warwick Close – an additional gully installed at the low point to resolve the problem.
 - Ashingdon Road, Holt Farm and St Teresa’s Primary Schools – vegetation clogging the drains –vegetation removed and new enlarged gullies installed.

Essex County Council Flood Team

3. Flood Park Magnolia Public Open Space – ECC now looking to have works carried out to increase capacity of the flood park.

Essex County Council Highways (ECCH)

4. Laburnum Way, Rayleigh - ECCH working on the redesign of the culvert.
5. Eastwood Rise, Rayleigh – ECCH clearance of gullies and channel servicing the surfaced carriageway.
6. Church Road, Hockley –highway gullies under the railway bridge.

7. Stambridge Road opposite Little Stambridge Hall Lane – ECCH to inspect drainage outside property, which is being flooded during heavy rainfall.
8. Downhall Road, Rayleigh – kerb stones level with driveways and water runs into properties – ECCH to inspect.
9. Highway Gullies across the District

Anglian Water Authority (AWA)

10. 24 High Road, Hockley – works scheduled to repair section to ensure tree roots won't grow back.

Rochford District Council (RDC)

11. Oak Road, Rochford – RDC to discuss with ECC Legal request for permission by residents to access the ditch at the rear of their properties via Ironwell Lane.
12. Hockley County Primary School – blockage to surface water pipe causing ditch to back up and flood Footpath 11, Hockley.
13. Old London Road, Fairglens interchange, Rawreth – flooding of the balancing pond. RTB to check who has responsibility.

Environmental Agency (EA)/Private Landowners

14. Barling Creek/Kimberley Road ditch – need to establish who has responsibility for ongoing maintenance.

Private Landowners

15. Nelson Road, Rayleigh – RDC has been in contact with the farmer who has arranged for the works to be carried out very shortly.
16. Fairmead, Rayleigh – Recent obstruction to 'U' channel cleared by RDC. Vegetation clearance required by land owner, Sanctuary Housing.
17. Glebe Drive, Rayleigh – flooding to residential property rear gardens and school playing field.
18. Milton Close/Bramfield Road East – 'V' shape channel, vegetation growth.
