PLEASE NOTE THAT IT IS AN OFFENCE UNDER SECTION 342 OF THE GAMBLING ACT 2005, TO GIVE ANY FALSE OR MISLEADING INFORMATION WITHIN THIS RETURN.

Notes:

1. The above information is required under Schedule 11, Part 4, Paragraph 39 (2) of the Gambling Act 2005.
2. This statement must be submitted **no later than three months** beginning on the day on which the draw (or last draw) in the lottery took place.
3. It must be signed by two members of the Society appointed in writing for that purpose by the Society or its governing body (if applicable) and **accompanied by a copy of that appointment.**
4. All signatories must be over the age of 18 years.
5. It is an offence to fail to submit a return as required, punishable on conviction by a fine of up to £5000.00 or imprisonment for up to 51 weeks or both.
6. Failure to submit a return may lead to the registration being revoked.
7. The information provided will be held by the council on computerised and manual files and may also be disclosed to other departments within the council or other organisations, but only in order to ensure compliance with relevant legislation or to detect and prevent fraud or a crime.
